Safety Stats

Do NOT Measure the Suffering from Injuries
Do NOT Measure the Stress on Families and others



Words have meanings and are POWERFUL! Talk to Employees about Zero Harm for All Zero Harm for All means, No Injuries **Results from Zero Injuries** No Pain **No Suffering** No Trauma **No Worry** These emotions are real when injuries happen.






Zero Harm for All Role Play

Driver is Texting and Driving
Passenger did NOT say something
Accident as a result of texting and driving.

Driver dies







Zero Harm for All Excuses for NOT saying something when you see something.

Not my responsibility
Person will get mad
Feel embarrassed



Discuss the Guilt feelings a person may have the rest of his/her life for <u>NOT</u> saying something.

Zero Harm for All How to use this presentation at your facility


On the red card, write how you would feel if you saw something, did <u>NOT</u> say something and a person dies or is seriously injured.
